

Edison Athletic Boosters
General Membership Meeting
March 8, 2011

Booster President, John Lewsi called the meeting to order at 7:02.

Lorri Keyser read the meeting minutes from the February 7 meeting. Bill Harris motioned to accept the minutes with minor revisions; Jim Teed seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Deb Divers presented financial reports as of 3/8/11. Dan McCoy motioned to accept financials; Jim Unger seconded the motion and motion carried.

Cory Smith discussed the track resurfacing project. Of the 2 contractors that reviewed and will quote project, one stated that a resurface was not adequate. There are a few more contractors set to review the project, so their needs evaluation is imperative.

Mark Suhanic and Cory Smith presented the stadium paver project to the group. Much discussion including pricing, layouts, sales and installation. Request for \$6000 to kick the project off. That money will be recouped with sales of bricks. Lorri Keyser motioned to allow for \$6000 to get project started; Jim Unger seconded the motion. All in favor and motion carried. Bricks will sell for \$75 – text only and \$100 for text & logo for the 8x4; and \$250 for the 8x8 with text only and \$500 w/text and logo. Sales will begin in April and run through May. Final details of sales will be rolled out at April meeting.

Golf Outing update from Jim Unger. First mailer being sent to businesses and participants. Wants to encourage people outside our community to join in the outing.

Jim Lewis informed group that Melon festival Committee and other non-profit organizations are selling Melon Ice Cream. \$6.50 a container. The Athletic Boosters opted out of this fundraiser.

Kevin Laughlin updated the group on concessions. About \$20,000 in sales. They had a joint effort with the band, where the profits were split.

Deb Divers motioned to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Tim Cox. Motion carried and meeting adjourned.
